- Treat players, opponents, coaches, officials, parents and other spectators, regardless
 of race, sex or creed with respect, relative to abusive language, gestures and actions.
- Not argue with an official's decision. I will treat officials as honest in their intentions and accept official decisions without displaying verbal and / or physical outbursts of anger.
- LEARN TEAMWORK, SPORTSMANSHIP, DISCIPLINE & RESPECT Whilst playing for fun. Be a TEAM PLAYER
 and get along with my team members. Appreciate and support the contribution
 each person makes to the team.
- Be on time to all games and practices. Be physically and mentally ready to work hard to improve my skills.
- Be dependable. Give coaches advance notice of upcoming absences.
- Learn the rules and play by them. Always be a good sport and set a good example.
 Understand that any behaviour that reflects poorly on my team or IHNSW may result in disciplinary action as decided by the coach or the IHNSW Tribunal.
- Understand that winning is desirable, but that winning at any cost defeats the purpose of the game. I will learn to lose with dignity and to win with grace.
- Understand that in Ice Hockey, as in life, I should treat others as I would have others treat me

The Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club's Player's Code of Conduct

Attendance at all training sessions, both on and off the ice, and games, is compulsory unless an acceptable excuse is provided to either the Team Manager or the Coach prior to the training sessions and games. Failure to do so may result in exclusion from the Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club (the Club).

While travelling and/or participating as a member of the Club:

- 1. All team members are required to be dressed in a neat and tidy manner at all times and wear the team uniform when required.
- 2. All team members will be required to behave in a manner deemed appropriate as a representative of the Club.
- 3. Proven possession of and/or consumption of illegal substances will not be tolerated.
- 4. Interfering with another team member or team member's personal effects will not be tolerated.
- 5. Any behaviour on or off the ice considered as bringing the Club into disrepute, or as being disruptive to the team, including but not limited to property damage to the Hunter Ice Skating Stadium and any other venue, will not be tolerated.

Any player found to have contravened the above Code of Conduct may be excluded from the Club. No prior payments/money paid will be refunded.

A report of any breach to the Code of Conduct will be given to the Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club Committee to deal with as they see fit.

The Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club's Child Protection and Harassment Policy

"The Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club aim to provide a safe environment for children and young people to play, learn and participate in the sport of Ice Hockey."

The Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club is committed to maintaining an environment that is free of any form of harassment or child abuse, and will implement current NSW Government legislation pertaining to Child Protection applicable to the Club and its members.

This policy applies to all members, officials, coaches, parents, guardians, spectators and sponsors.

Child Protection

Any allegation of child abuse is a serious criminal matter and must be handled with a high degree of sensitivity.

Any complaints, concerns or allegations of child abuse should be made, or referred, to the Committee. The initial response of the person who receives the complaint from the child (or person on behalf of the child) is crucial to the well-being of the child.

- It is important for the person receiving the information to listen, be supportive and not dispute the disclosure.
- They should reassure the child that what has occurred is not their fault.
- Ensure the child is safe.
- ❖ Be honest and explain to the child that other persons may need to be told in order to put a stop to what is happening.
- Ensure that what the child says is quite clear but do not elicit information about the abuse.

Any individual, to whom this policy applies, should immediately report any incident of a serious criminal nature to the police or other government authority. If the allegation is of a criminal nature, report the incident immediately to the police. If the allegation involves a child at risk of harm you may need to report the matter to the police or relevant government agency.

For allegations of a less serious nature (verbal abuse) the Child Protection Officer shall make contact with each of the people involved and obtain details of the allegation.



Harassment

Harassment is any type of behaviour that the other person does not want or does not return and that is offensive, abusive, belittling, intimidating or threatening whether it is face to face, indirectly via communications technologies such as mobile telecommunication devices and computers. The behaviour is unwelcome and of a type that a person of reasonable firmness would feel intimidated, offended or humiliated.

Cyber Bullying

The Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club acknowledges the emergence of new technologies and communication mediums such as social networking. Bullying and harassment is regarded as totally unacceptable in Ice Hockey. Bullying has the potential to cause great anxiety and distress to the person who has been the target of comments or statements. In some cases, bullying is regarded as a criminal offence. Frustration at officials, team members, coaches or the Club should never been communicated through social networking channels, but instead by way of reasoned and logical verbal and written statements and, where appropriate, to the Committee.

Mediation

The Newcastle North Stars Ice Hockey Club aims to sort out complaints with the minimum of fuss wherever possible. In most cases complaints can be dealt with through an agreement between the parties. Mediation may occur either before or after an investigation of a complaint. If the complainant wishes to try to resolve the matter with the assistance of a mediator the Child Protection Officer, in consultation with the complainant, will arrange for a mediator to oversee the complaint.
